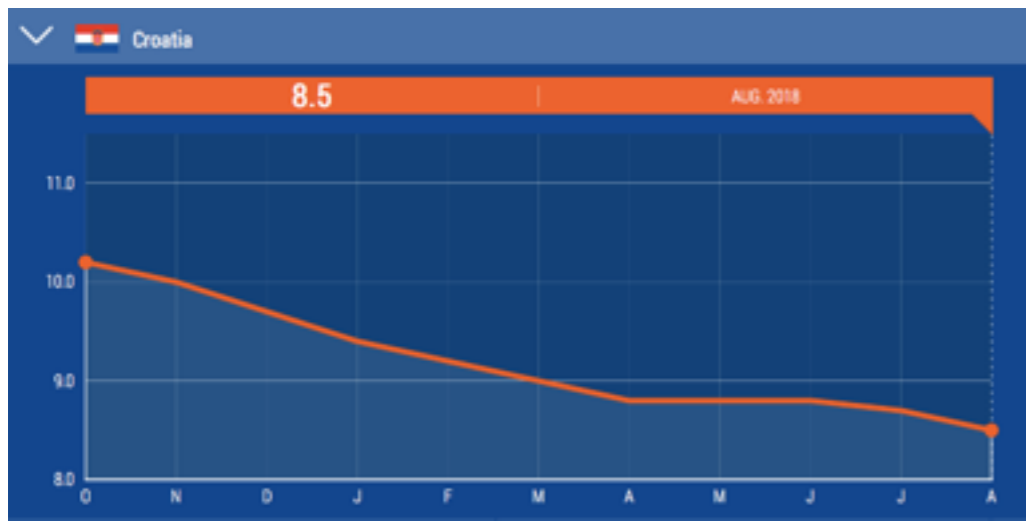

The data which we have will be really important for our countries to improve and find the solution for problems.





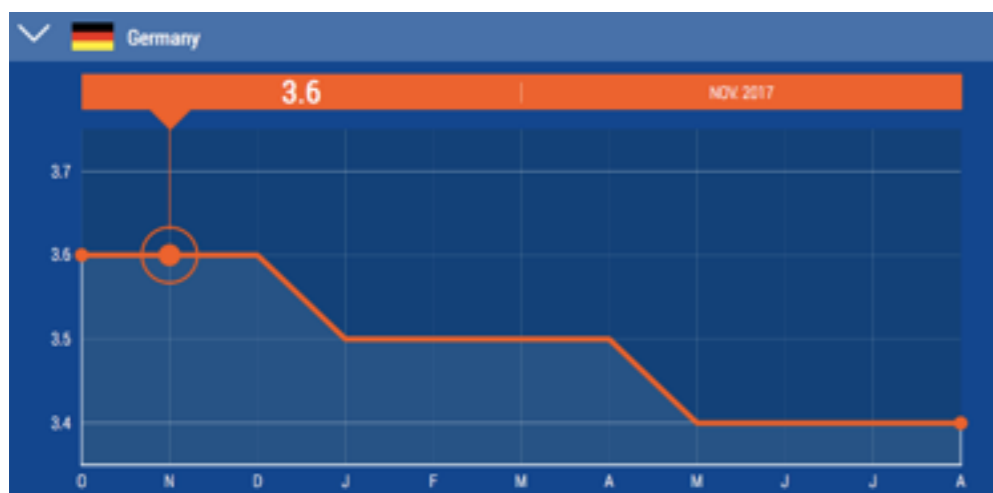
Croatia:

reasons for unemployment: emigration, immobility, tax, offshoring, volunteering, unwise choice of career, pride, advances in technology (emerging economy)



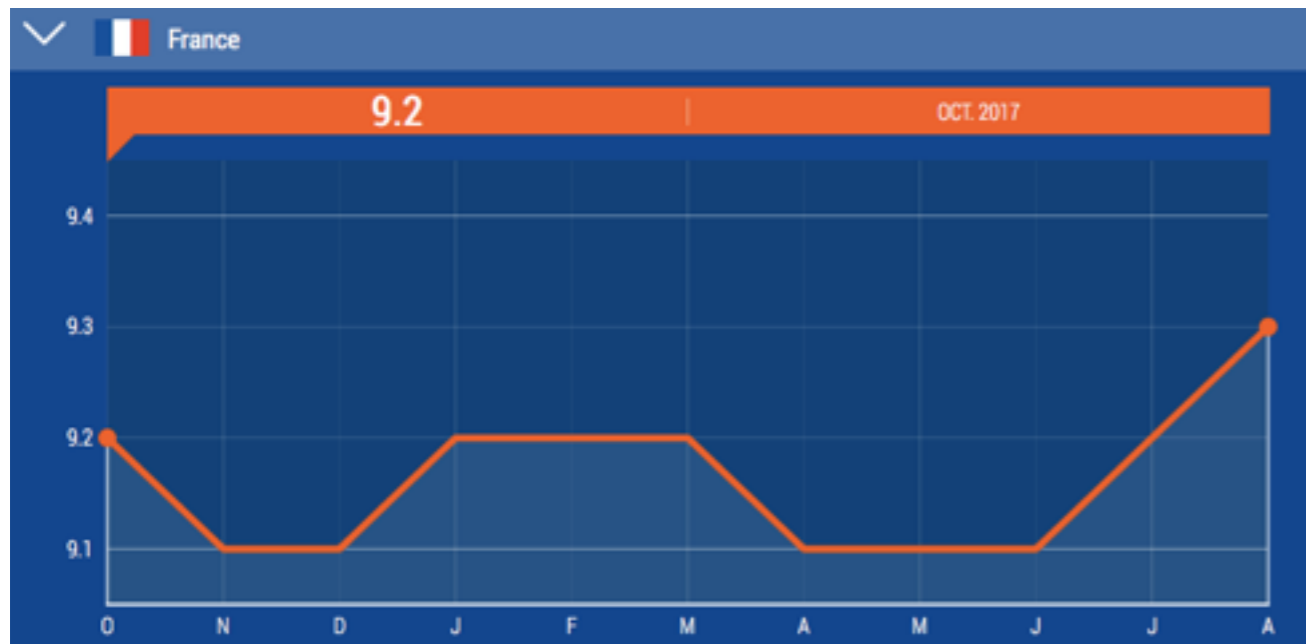
Italy:
